Use of Private Transportation Insurance Statement

The Michigan No Fault Law provides that parents' insurance policy on their child is primary with the driver of the vehicle's insurance being secondary. Therefore, it is important that drivers of nondistrict owned vehicles have adequate insurance and should not rely on any school district insurance. Employees and volunteers are not insured by the district when driving non-district owned vehicles.

The Birmingham Public Schools <u>does not</u> provide primary insurance coverage for non-district owned or hired automobiles. The insurance provided by the Birmingham Public Schools for non-district owned or hired automobile use is in excess of any other valid and collectible insurance available to the insured and protects <u>only</u> the school district.
